What is certification?

Bonsucro offers a credible, metric certification process to demonstrate commitment to environmental and social sustainability in sugarcane. A Bonsucro certificate is internationally recognised and respected. By achieving a certificate, you can improve your image, achieve sustainability procurement goals, build partnerships to tackle sustainability issues together.

Two standards for certification

There are two types of Bonsucro certification—one on the production end of the supply chain and one on the trading side of the supply chain. The two work together to ensure that sugarcane production benefits producer communities, ensures people are treated fairly and creates long-lasting, traceable supply chains.

Production Standard

The Production Standard helps farmers and mills to measure their productivity alongside key environmental and social impacts. It can be used by all sugarcane mills and farms to demonstrate sustainable production, regardless of size.

Businesses that use the Bonsucro Production Standard:

- Increase efficiency
- Lower energy use
- Decrease water use
- Reduce waste
- Create a safe working environment
- Lower energy use
- Increase market viability



The Chain of Custody Standard enables brands to trace sugarcane from the origin to the end product. It allows brands to make sustainability claims about their sugarcane sourcing.

The Chain of Custody Standard relates to the supply of a product including all stages, from the feedstock production to consumption. It demonstrates:





- Assurance of compliance
- Increased supply chain visibility

Chain of Custody certification helps to understand your supply chains and mitigate risks. A certificate also:

- Gives you the option to make on product claims
